There is one piece in the Remington Gallery **NOT** sculpted by **Frederic Remington**. Who is the artist?

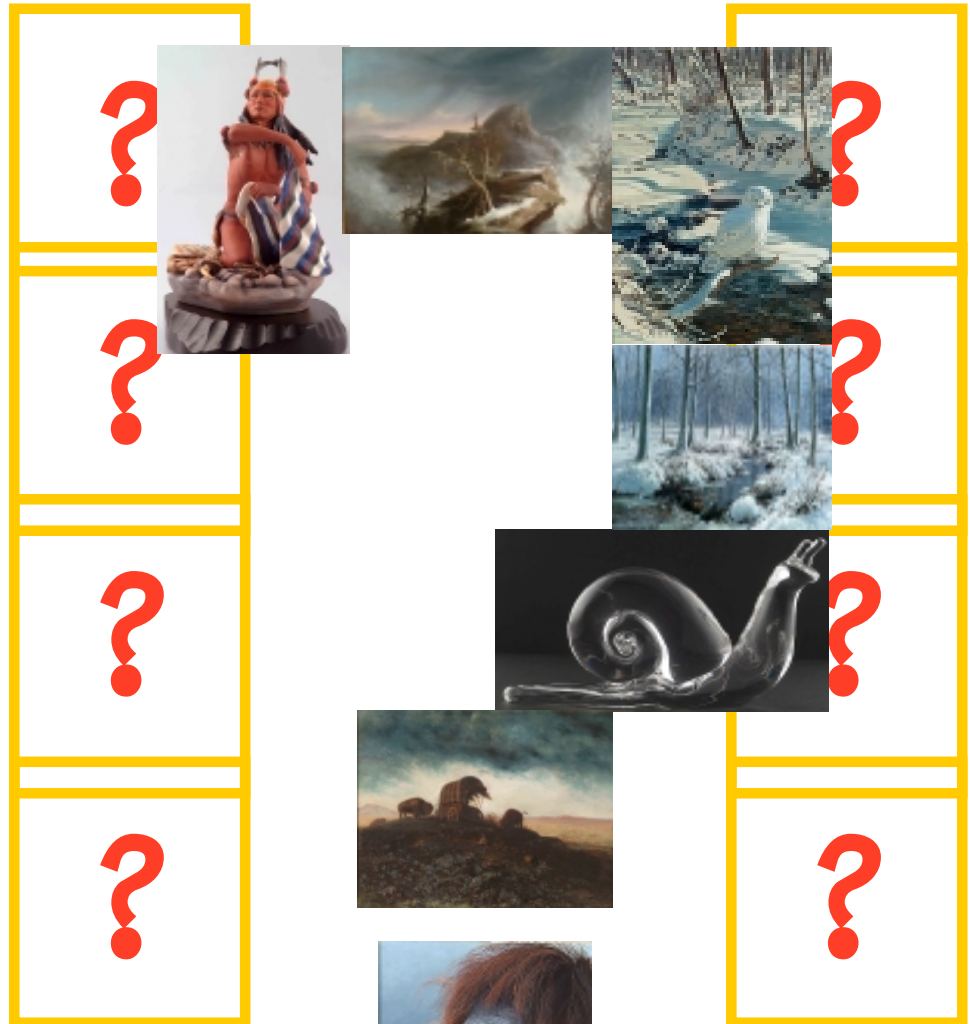
What bird is on display in **John James Audubon's** double elephant folio edition of Birds of America?

This artist was part of America's first art movement, the **Hudson River School**, and was instrumental in establishing the National Park Service. This is *Emigrants Resting at Sunset*.

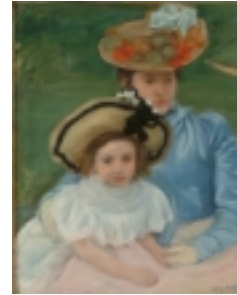
Who painted it?
